Connections From the Airports

From Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport
Coaches that travel directly to Taipei, Banqiao, Xindian, Taoyuan, Zhongli, Taichung and Changhua are available both in Terminal 1 and 2 (T1 and T2).
Passengers please inquire at the ticket counter.
T1 pickup and drop off point: B1, Arrival Hall.
T2 pickup and drop off point: Northeast side of the first floor, Arrival Hall.

Taiwan High Speed Rail
Trains to Taoyuan Station are available at both T1 and T2.
24-hour taxi services are available at both T1 and T2.
Depending on the traveler's needs, the taxi drivers can take passengers to all corners of Taiwan, charging reasonable and standard fares.

From Taipei Songshan Airport
This airport is situated in the Taipei urban area, providing convenient transportation.
A Taipei station and city buses are located near the departure hall.
Taxi charging standards fares according to taxi meters.

From Taipei Chiang Kai-shek Airport
Tourists can take the city bus to Taichung Railway Station and Taichung High Speed Rail Station to connect to other metropolitan areas. Fares vary depending on distances.

From Kaohsiung International Airport
In the airport terminal, tourists can take the Red Line Kaohsiung Mass Rapid Transit to Kaohsiung Railway Station (Main Station) or to the High Speed Rail Zongying Station and travel to other cities. 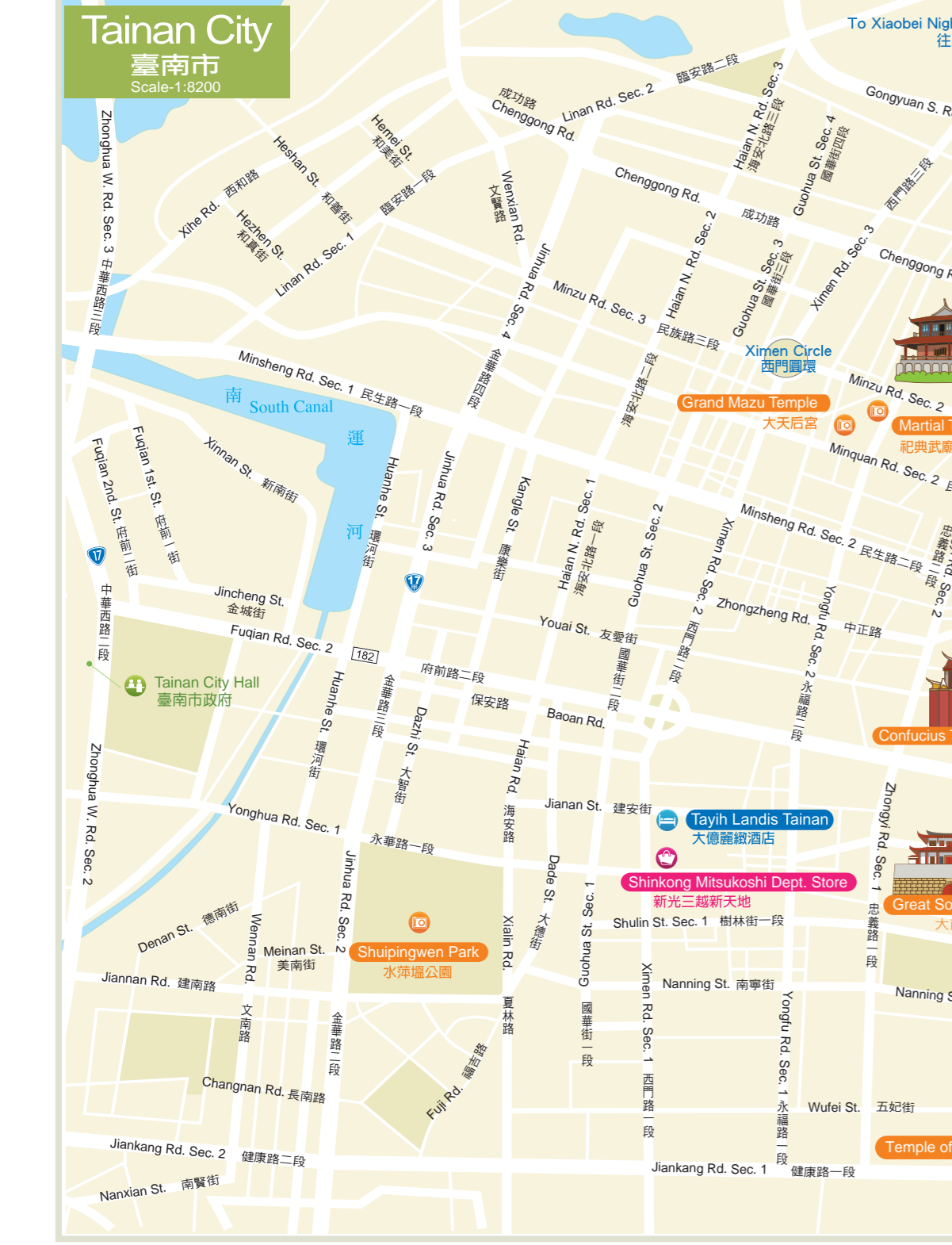
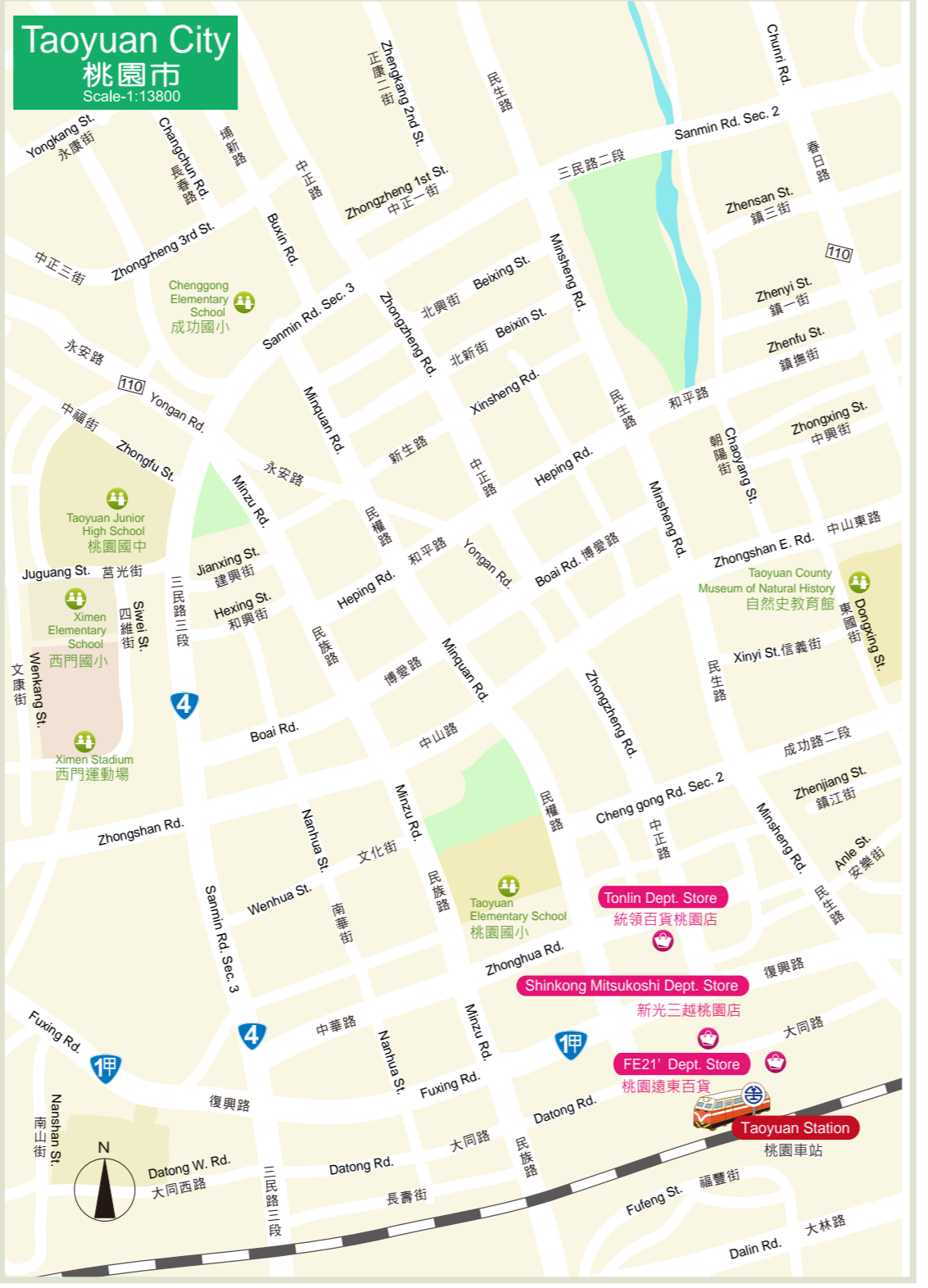
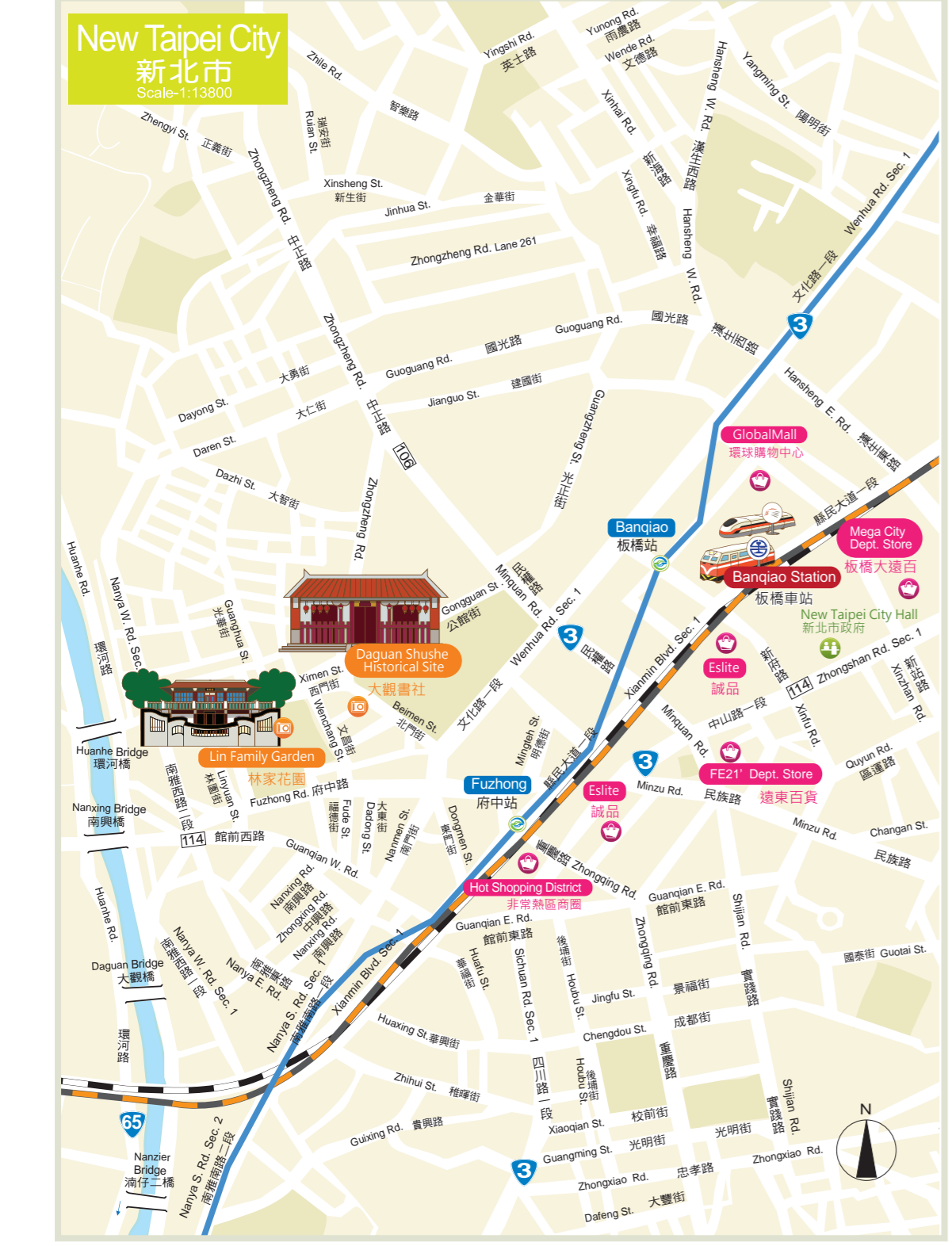
Traveler's Cheques and Credit Cards
Please exchange your traveler's cheques in advance. Traveler's cheques are not accepted in most shops in Taiwan, whereas credit cards are rather popular. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, China UnionPay, Diners Clubs International are well accepted. If you travel in the Taiwan countryside, make sure you prepare enough cash in case credit card service is not available.

Voltage and Power Socket
Taiwan uses 110V or 220V electric current, and the frequency is 60Hz. Please note your electronic appliance specifications brought from abroad.
The common power socket is type A, therefore a power converter is suggested.

Tax and Tax Refund
Commonly tax is usually included in the bill for purchases, no additional fees are charged.
Standard receipts will be given after purchase.
If you wish to claim your tax refund, please shop at authorized Tax Refund Stores (TRS). With purchases totaling NT\$2,000 or more in one store on a given day, you can get a tax refund at the airport or customs stations within 30 days of making the purchase or before you go through customs in the airport's departure hall.

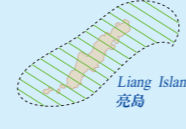
Service Charge

Travelers from abroad may apply for a free account with proper visa or passport documentation.

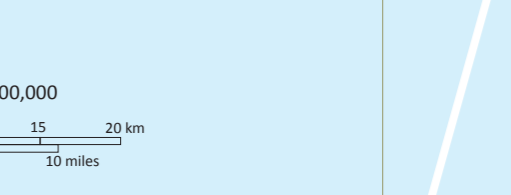
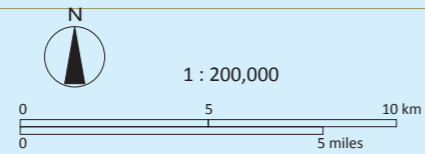


MAP OF TAIWAN

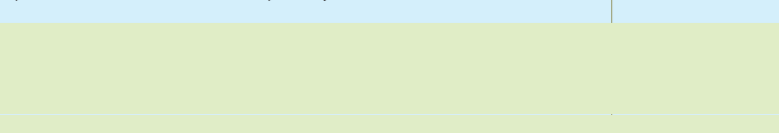

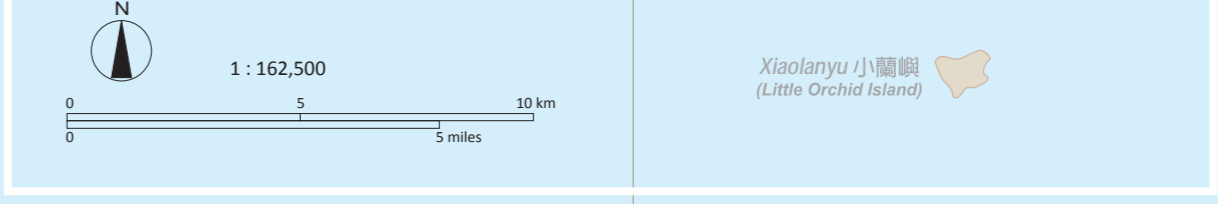
